PAYMENT OPTIONS

When enrolling in summer camps, all students must reserve their spot ahead of time with a \$15-25 non-refundable deposit. The remaining balance is due, in full, on the first day of camp via card or cash only. We do not accept checks.

CANCELLATION POLICY

If a family is not able to attend camp or would like to cancel their enrollment, we will then save their deposit and use it towards a future camp, class or other program. We do not refund the deposits.

If a family decides to cancel after camp has begun, we will apply their unused portion as a credit for future camps, classes or other programs at Illuminar. There is absolutely no refunds for camps after the camp has begun as this takes away from a potential spot that could have been filled by another student.

CHECK IN PROCEDURES

- All students must be enrolled and registered for camp through our iclass registration system. All families must create an account, accept and electronically sign our online waiver before camp has begun.
- Families are allowed to drop off their child(ren) 5-10 minutes before camp has begun, as long as there is a camp instructor present.
- Please be sure to inform your coaches of any food allergies that your child(ren) has before the start of camp.
- Please inform your coaches if someone different will be picking up your child(ren) at the end of camp.

LUNCH POLICIES

- All students must bring a sack lunch to eat during camp each day. Illuminar does not provide lunch or snacks to campers.
- We have a strict NO PEANUT BUTTER policy due to so many children having peanut allergies. Please do not bring any sort of peanut/peanut butter item in their lunch bags.
- If your child has an food allergies, including peanut butter, please make sure you communicate this with your camp coaches.
- All students will be instructed to wash their hands before lunch time.

CAMP POLICIES

- Only students are allowed in the studio space for camps. All parents and siblings must hang out in the viewing room or in the downstairs lobby during the camp time.
- Students must wait in the viewing room and will be called in by their camp coaches when camp is beginning. Students are not allowed to hang out in the studio space if they are early to camp.
- Do not wear any kind of lotion, cream, or oil of any sort on any part of your body the day of or the night before class. Chemicals and oils in these lotions damage and ruin the equipment and cause it to be un-safe to use. Illuminar reserves the right to sit a student out for camp if they are covered in lotion!
- Wear tight fitting clothes that will cover the torso, backs of the knees and armpit areas. Leotard, tights and a tight fitting shirt that covers the armpits is best. Tights should go a bit down past their knees to cover the back side but should not cover their feet. Boys/Men can wear long athletic shorts or pants and we recommend biker shorts underneath, as the majority of our work is upside down! Please avoid baggy clothes as this will get caught in the fabric and ropes. Do not wear any clothing that has zippers, buckles, buttons or anything else sharp that can tear our fabric. Jeans are not allowed.
- No jewelry is allowed during camp, including earrings. These can get caught in the silk and can rip the fabric, so please take off everything before camp.
- Any cuts, scrapes or open wounds must be covered with a band-aid and with athletic tape before camp time to prevent the wound from reopening and getting blood on any equipment. Athletic tape is required as a band-aid will come right off after a few minutes of climbing on the equipment.

- Hair must be worn up to maintain a safe working environment for class. You need to see clearly when hanging upside down.
- WASH hands before camp time, and if needed, your feet too to keep the equipment clean! If needed, we will instruct children to wash their hands and feet before camp.
- Please maintain your personal hygiene. Aerial arts is a very close contact art form and maintaining good personal hygiene is essential in a positive work environment and courteous to other classmates.
- No flash photography during camp time is allowed. Photos without flash is acceptable.

ARRIVAL AND PICKUP

Be sure you/your child arrives around 5 to 10 minutes before his/her scheduled camp time. Please also pick up your student on time. We allow a 15 minute window after camp for any parents running late. Any additional time after that is charged to your account to pay for the instructor waiting with your child. Please inform us if you know you will be late picking up your student. Instruct your student to wait inside the building and you should escort them from the building to your car. During peak times the parking lot is crowded. Please take into consideration that our students include young children. Please drive slowly and carefully. Do not take a chance on your student running to and from your car.
